CHAMPIONSHIPS POLICY

Provincial Championships

- a) There shall be at least 1 Provincial Championship per year, dates to be tentative based on the National competitive schedule.
- b) CADA (MS) Inc. member clubs shall host the Provincial Championships on a rotating basis.
- c) CADA (MS) Inc. will direct the Hosting Grant towards the hosting club.
- d) Sanction fees, pool costs, medals, awards, etc. shall be the responsibility of the Host Committee.
- e) All entry fees (including registration fees) shall be determined by the Host Committee.
- f) When possible, the Senior and the Age Group Provincials will be combined with the Tier II and should be prior to the closing date of the Summer Senior National entries.
- g) One set of medals shall be given per event. Should an out-of-province competitor win, place second or third, that diver would be given the gold medal, silver or bronze medal.
- h) CADA (MS) Inc. shall present each Manitoba Champion with a certificate of Achievement. (The Manitoba Champion is defined as the highest ranking Manitoban in each event.)
- i) The Technical Director will forward the names of the awardees to the Executive Director to develop the certificate.

Novice Championships

- a) When possible, CADA (MS) Inc. will endeavour to host a Novice Championship.
- b) The rules for the Championship shall be set out and distributed on an event-by-event basis.
- c) Registration fees shall be set out and distributed on an event-by-event basis.
- d) Information regarding the event shall be sent to all active clubs and programs in Manitoba by the Executive Director at least 15 days prior to the event.
