DIVE MANITOBA WINTER PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

This springboard and platform diving competition, will include many levels of competition:

National (Diving Plongeon Canada rules),
Novice (Western Canada Tier II rules),
Open (FINA & Diving Plongeon Canada rules),
Masters (FINA rules) and **Novice Masters** (local rules).

We will also be holding a **Head-to-Head RIP CONTEST** for all ages of divers!

This competition is sanctioned by Diving Canada as a qualifier. The “National (DPC)” events for age group divers will be qualifiers for Diving Canada’s 2022 Junior National Championships. The Open events will be qualifiers for Diving Canada’s 2022 Senior National Championships.

THE FACILITY

Pan-Am Pool
25 Poseidon Bay
Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada

Built in 1967 for the Pan-American Games, the Pan-Am Pool was Canada’s original indoor Olympic sized pool, and it is still one of the biggest aquatic facilities in Canada. In 1999 the Pan Am Pool received a facelift in preparation for the 1999 Pan American Games, and again in 2017 prior to the Canada Summer Games. In 2017, Manitoba Diving acquired a new training room exclusive to divers complete with two trampolines, two dryboards and bouncy floor.

The diving facilities include:

- 2 x 1-meter Maxiflex “C” springboards
- 2 x 3-meter Maxiflex “C” springboards
- A freestanding concrete tower including 3m, 5m, 7.5m and 10 m platforms (all platforms are wide enough for synchronized diving)

The diving tank is 16 feet deep and offers a bubbler system located under the 5m and 10m platforms as well as under the 3m springboards as well as water sprayers under all boards.

Entry Fees: \$ 35.00 per Competitor (includes \$10.00 judging fee)
\$ 25.00 per Event (to a maximum of \$100.00 per athlete in event fees)
Entry fees will be due at the conclusion of the competition.

Rules:

Rules for National qualifying events will be Diving Plongeon Canada's 2022 Junior Rules.
If any discrepancy exists between this information package and the Diving Plongeon Canada rulebook, the DPC rulebook shall prevail. See www.diving.ca for 2022 rules outline.
Rules for Novice events will be the western Canadian Novice rules.
Age group is determined based on the diver's age as of December 31, 2022.
All events will be straight finals.

Awards:

Awards will be presented for each event directly after the event.
Masks covering nose and mouth must be worn during presentations.

Hospitality:

At this time, we are not offering food hospitality for athletes.
If this changes, we will notify all registered teams with new information.
Lunch will be provided for judges and coaches.
Athletes can bring their own lunches and snacks.
Please be sure to tidy after yourself and put all garbage in the bins.

Schedule:

The event schedule is attached separately.

There will be open practice available on Thursday, February 10, times TBD based on the number of divers registered and Covid regulations at the time.

There will be NO open practices on competition days.

Each event will have a 30-minute practice directly prior to the event. Events with few divers or few dives may have a 20-minute practice at the discretion of the technical director.

Any additional designated practice times will be outlined on the final schedule.

Events may run up to 30 minutes ahead of schedule.

Dive Sheets:

Email rezman dive sheets to entries.revolutiondiving@gmail.com by Tuesday at 5:00 pm to facilitate entry organization for this event.

Computers will be set up at the pool on Thursday. Please visit the computer area to ensure that your dives sheets are correctly entered.

For National Age Group events, use "Group A", "Group B", "Group C", "Group D"

For Novice Level events, use suffix "Tier II" – eg. "Group A Tier II" for all age groups

For Masters events, use "Open Tier II" (the system will not allow Masters events to be scheduled in the same competition as non-Masters events)

If you have any questions, please contact the Technical Director by email or the Computer Coordinator in person on pool deck.

Dive sheets must be submitted 24 hours prior to the event.

Late entries are \$50 per diver per event and will be accepted up to 1 hour prior to the event's posted start time.

Changes to dive sheets must be submitted a minimum of 1 hour prior to the event's posted start time.

No new dive sheets and no changes to entered dive sheets will be accepted within 1 hour of the posted start time of the event.

NOVICE LEVEL EVENTS

Novice level events follow rules set out by the western provinces for Age Group A, B, C, D and E.

A diver may compete in a Novice level event as soon as they have the minimum dives required.

A diver may compete in National level events and in Provincial and/or Novice events on different boards; but a diver cannot compete in both the National level event and the Provincial or Novice event on the same board.

<p>Group C 12-13</p>	<p>1m (6 dives): 3 dives with 5.4 d.d. limit, 3 dives without d.d. limit (4 Dir) 3m (5 dives): 3 dives with 5.7 d.d. limit, 2 dives without d.d. limit (3 Dir) Platform (5 dives): 001D or 002D + 4 dives (3 Dir)</p>
<p>Group B 14-15</p>	<p>1m (7 dives): 4 dives with 7.2 d.d. limit, 3 without d.d. limit (4 Dir) 3m (6 dives): 3 dives with 5.7 d.d. limit, 3 without d.d. limit (4 Dir) Platform (6 dives): 3 dives with 5.7 d.d. limit, 3 without d.d. limit (4 Dir)</p>
<p>Group A 16-18</p>	<p>1m (8 dives): 4 dives with 7.2 d.d. limit, 4 without d.d. limit (4 Dir) 3m (7 dives): 4 dives with 7.6 d.d. limit, 3 without d.d. limit (4 Dir) Platform (6 dives): 3 dives with 5.7 d.d. limit, 3 without d.d. limit (4 Dir)</p>
<p>Notes:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Divers qualified for the Junior National Championships on any board are not eligible to compete in Novice events. • All Jumps and Fall-ins are D.D. 1.0 • Above, dives specified as 'Dives' must not be jumps or fall-ins (except in Group E). • Dives in position D means you can choose the position, but you must specify the choice.

001 = Front fall-in

002 = Back Fall-in

D = choice of position, **pos. must be specified**

MASTERS EVENTS

In age groups 25 to 69 years, each dive performed must have different dive number (FINA DD).

In 70+ age groups, the same dive number can be repeated using a different position (A, C or B) in dives with the same dive number. The number of dives required for each age group is:

Age	Men	Women
18 – 29	7	6
30 – 49	7	6
50 – 69	6	5
70 – 79	5	4
80 +	4	3

NOVICE MASTERS EVENTS

Novice Masters may use 100, 200, 001 and/or 002 as dives.

Each dive performed must have different dive number.

Based on the following age groups, the number of dives required is:

Age	Men	Women
18 – 29	4	4
30 – 49	4	4
50 +	4	4

RIP CONTEST HEAD-TO-HEAD

This event will include a head-to-head bracket where divers will face off against each other in elimination rounds.

Divers from all age groups are invited and encouraged to participate.

The exact format will depend on how many divers sign up. More information will be provided on Friday during the competition.
