2023 Great-Britain Elite Nationals Championships (GROUP C, B & A)

April 13th – 15th, 2023

&

2023 Dresden Youth International Invitational (GROUP B & A)

April 27th – 30th, 2023

THE TRIALS:

Event: The Polar Bear
Location: Winnipeg, MN
Dates: March 16th-19th, 2023

TEAM SIZE:

- Athletes and coaches determined by selection process
- 1 team manager, 1 official

TRAVEL DATES:

2023 Great-Britain Elite Nationals Championships (Plymouth): April 9th-16th, 2023
2023 Dresden Youth International Invitational: April 23rd – May 1st, 2023

DIVER FEES

- A diver fee of \$700 will be levied for each athlete who is selected.

ATHLETE'S SELECTION PROCESS:

2023 Dresden Youth international Invitational

Team size: A maximum of 2 athletes will be selected for the 3m event and the platform event for each age group (A & B) and gender.

Selection 1: Automatic selection

1. Gold medalist who achieves the Junior International Standard A in the finals of the individual events; 3m and platform
2. Silver medalists who achieve the Junior International Standard A in the finals of the individual events: 3m and platform.

If spots remain open after selection 1,

Selection 2: Discretionary selection

1. Gold medalist who achieves the Junior International Standard B in the finals of the individual events; 3m and platform will be considered for selection

Note: Athletes selected for the 2023 Dresden Youth International Invitational are not eligible for the 2023 Great-Britain Elite Nationals selection.

Team size: A maximum of 2 athletes will be selected for the 3m event and the platform event for each age group (C, B & A) and gender.

GROUP C SELECTION SPECIFICATION: To be eligible for the selection, athletes will have to comply with the following rules:

- **3M:**
 - All dives must be selected from the 2023 Group C Finals Dive Chart
 - First 5 dives:
 - 5 groups must be represented
 - Last 3 dives:
 - 3 groups must be represented
 - Must perform a dive from group 200 or 300
 - Cannot use 202 or 302



- **PLATFORM:**
 - All dives must be selected from the 2023 Group C Finals Dive Chart
 - Last 3 dives:
 - Must perform a dive from group 200 or 300

Selection 1: Automatic selection

1. Gold medalist (group C), and the top ranked eligible diver (group B & A) who achieve the Junior International Standard B in the finals of the individual events; 3m and platform
2. Silver medalists (group C), and the 2nd top ranked eligible diver (group B & A) who achieve the Junior International Standard B in the finals of the individual events; 3m and platform.

If a spot remains open after selection 1,

Selection 2:

1. Bronze medalist (group C only) who achieves the Junior International Standard B in the finals of the individual events; 3m and platform,

SELECTION DETAILS

- Selection will be made on the final results for each age division in each event at The Polar Bear based on the Canadian Rules list of dives.
- Should a diver be ineligible to represent Canada, they will be removed from the event results prior to the selection process for selection purposes, and all lower ranking divers will be moved up accordingly.



COACH SELECTION:

For each of the competition,

- Coaches determined on a ratio of 4 divers per assigned coach
- Coach selection is based on the program(s) with the highest percentage of total Diver Points.

NOTE: Program is defined by where the athlete predominately trains

- Canadian Diving Institute – Montreal
- Canadian Diving Institute – Toronto
- Canadian Diving Institute- Saskatoon
- Canadian Diving Institute – Victoria
- Canadian Diving Institute – Calgary
- Club program

Selection :

Diver Points will be calculated using the following system:

Diver points for Coach Selection	
7 points	First Selected athlete – making the point standard A
5 points	Second Selected athlete – making the point standard A
3 points	First Selected athlete – making the point standard B
1 point	Second Selected athlete– making the point standard B

- Programs will be ranked based on the total of diver points achieved
- Where there is a tie between programs in the Coach Selection, the program with the largest number of athletes on the team will be selected.
- If a tie still exists, the program with the most first selected athletes will be selected.
- If a tie still exists, the program with the cumulative highest percentage of the point standards on the 3m and platform individual events, will be selected. This will be determined by adding the percentage of the point standard of all 3m and platform of the selected athletes for each program.
- If a tie still exists, the program with the highest number of events will be selected.
- DPC's Technical Staff reserves the right to send a reserve coach when circumstances are appropriate.
- Athletes without their personal coach attending will be assigned to one of the team coaches as determined by the athlete's coach and DPC's technical staff.

SELF-FUNDING COACH

- There will be not self-funding opportunity for coaches for these events.



SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Inability to train or compete.

Should anything occur following the trials that may inhibit a selected diver's performance or ability to compete (injury or other circumstance) and before departure to the international competition to which he/she has been selected, it is the **responsibility of the diver and their coach** to immediately inform the Chief Technical Officer and the Junior High Performance Director.

The Chief Technical Officer and the Junior High Performance Director will review the report. An athlete, whose performance ability or ability to prepare for or be prepared at the upcoming trip/competition, may be removed from the team and replaced by an alternate diver.

Failure to report an injury or other circumstance which inhibits the diver's performance or ability to compete, pending a review by the Chief Technical Officer and Junior High Performance Director, the diver may be required to reimburse Diving Plongeon Canada for any expenses incurred.

PLEASE NOTE

The DPC Technical Staff has the final jurisdiction over the selection of the Team. Where there is a lack of clarity or if unanticipated circumstances arise that are not covered in the selection criteria, a final and binding decision will be made by the DPC Technical Staff.
